

**NAME**

t1lint – check a PostScript Type 1 font for correctness

**SYNOPSIS**

**t1lint** *font* [*font...*]

**DESCRIPTION**

**T1lint** checks PostScript Type 1 font programs for correctness. Any errors or variances from the specification are reported to standard error. If there are no errors, the command prints nothing. It exits with status 0 if all fonts were OK, and status 1 otherwise. If no input files are supplied, t1lint reads a font from the standard input.

**OPTIONS**

**-q, --quiet**

Do not generate any error messages. The only output will be the exit status.

**-h, --help**

Print usage information and exit.

**-v, --version**

Print the version number and some short non-warranty information and exit.
